EXECUTIVE SESSION
WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 31, 2018

The Special Council Meeting of Wednesday, October 31, 2018 adjourned into Executive Session at 8:00am. To discuss appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance, or dismissal of specific employees pursuant to Section 2(c)(1) and sale of real property owned by the City pursuant to Section 2(c)(6) of the Open Meetings Act. Councilman Considine, Marshall, Marx, Venier, and Mayor Arellano were present. Also present were City Manager Danny Langloss, Assistant City Manager Matt Heckman, Finance Director Becky Fredericks, and City Clerk Keesha Blumhoff.

CLOSE SESSION MINUTES

Started at 8:02am.

City Manager Langloss let the council know that Paul Shiaras, Building & Zoning Manager, is planning to retire in August. Fire Chief Tim Shipman has expressed interest in the position. He is eligible to retire from the Fire Department, and has been considering it. With those pending retirements Langloss has been looking at staff and what can be accomplished with restructuring departmental duties. Curt Phillis, Public Properties, hasn't been able to maintain other properties other than the cemetery. Discussion ensued regarding job performance, merging department duties, and how this will affect departments. The option of looking into selling Oakwood Cemetery was brought to the table, discussion ensued.

The consensus of the Council was to have the City Manager look into what it would entail to sell Oakwood Cemetery, if even a possible option in the future. To go ahead with the reorganization of the departments.
