

Dixon Riverfront Commission Minutes  
July 10, 2013

**A meeting of the Dixon Riverfront Commission was held on Wednesday, July 10, 2013, at 6:00 P.M. at Dixon City Hall.**

<b>Present</b>	Chairman Larry Reed, Wendell Snell, John Varga, Coral Tichler, Paul Miller, David Ames, Bill Weronko, Nancy Fritts.
<b>Review and Approval Minutes</b>	Larry Reed reviewed the minutes. Paul Miller approved the minutes, David Ames seconded. Minutes approved by voice vote.
<b>Treasurer's Report</b>	Coral Tichler provided a Treasurer Report for the period of June 1 <sup>st</sup> through June 30 <sup>th</sup> , 2013 showing the Foundation account at \$35,138.84 and the maintenance account at \$19,137.01. The report will be placed in line for audit.
<b>New Business</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Public addressed the Board: Joel Bonnell addressed the Board about “Adopt a Flower Bed” where organizations would weed and care for a flower bed under John Groshans’ supervision. Larry Reed suggested a Saturday morning meet with coffee then clean-up. Dennis Moore addressed the Board about the boat dock project progress.</li> <li>• John Groshans discussed maintenance and new landscape along Topsy’s and a broken water pipe in the bathroom. Discussion was also in favor of renting a golf cart from Razor for John Groshans to use on the Riverfront. John Varga motioned to rent a golf cart for 9 months at \$40.00 per month. Wendell Snell seconded the motion. All voice vote “yes”</li> <li>• Larry Reed brought in an eagle from the Riverfront with a broken wing. John Varga said he will get it fixed.</li> <li>• Larry Reed discussed the Petunia Festival Review. Dave Johnson from the Petunia Board spoke and said the Festival was well beyond successful. Dennis Moore suggested possibly moving the pancake breakfast to the Riverfront as well next year. It will be looked into.</li> <li>• The Drawdown will be July 20<sup>th</sup> at 6:00PM</li> <li>• The boat docks were addressed again. Due to lack of funds to put the docks in and maintenance of the docks, it will be discussed at a later date.</li> <li>• Larry Reed discussed the IDOT Enhancement Program briefly on the Tiger Program Grant. He encouraged all to go to: <a href="http://discoverdixon.com">discoverdixon.com</a> and click on Support Tiger.</li> <li>• Commonwealth Edison will be replacing 15 towers in the riverfront area. Bill Weronko will follow up on the project.</li> <li>• Karrie Davis will be the new reporter covering our meetings for WIXN.</li> <li>• Eric Brantley would like to donate some tables for the riverfront but the Board discussed possible storage issues and uncertainty of the direction the Board is going, so we will wait on this issue.</li> <li>• John Varga motioned to move forward on maintenance of a sealer for the riverfront. Coral Tichler seconded the motion. Motion to move forward with voice vote “yes”.</li> </ul>
