A meeting of the Dixon Riverfront Commission was held on Tuesday, October 8, 2013, at 6:00 P.M. at the Dixon Public Service Building

Review and Approval Minutes	Larry Reed reviewed the minutes. Bill Weronko moved to approve the minutes of September 10, 2013, Paul Miller seconded. Minutes approved by voice vote.
Treasurer's Report	Coral Tichler provided a Treasurer Report for the period of September 1 st through September 30 th , 2013 showing the Foundation account at \$35,172.14 and the Maintenance account at \$18,448.22. The report will be placed in line for audit.
New Business	<p>John Groshans reports on the Riverfront.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Three new picnic tables were placed at the east end of Heritage crossing. KSB provided funding to cover material cost of \$360.00. They replaced tables that had deteriorated. ✓ The pump motor for the fountains was repaired with a new capacitor. Hill's Electric did the repairs. One additional capacitor was purchased as a standby part. Total cost was \$95.33. ✓ The sealer for pavers and the black concrete stain is being replaced by John when weather permits. ✓ Lee County Democratic Central Committee has donated \$120.00 for two new American flags for the Riverfront. ✓ Two pool lights are burned out. Should they be replaced yet this fall was the question. No, replace next spring at pool start up. <p>Paul Miller reported;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ That he wrote a grant to the Blackhawk Waterways & Visitor's Bureau for a Timeline brochure. ✓ He will be attending a meeting with Dixon Tourism to see if a Kiosk like the one placed at the Lowell Park Nature Center is something they would be interested in. He will report back at our next meeting.
