Wastewater Treatment Plant Superintendent Dan Mahan advised that more repairs are needed per the contractor that arrived at the plant on September 16th to do the original repair work. Commissioner Considine moved to authorize the Wastewater Treatment Plant Aeration Unit Impeller Repair Project cost not to exceed \$50,000. MOTION TO WAIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR WELL #5 REPAIR PROJECT

Commissioner Considine moved to waive the bidding requirements for Well #5 Repair Project. Discussion followed. Water Superintendent Rusty Cox gave a brief synopsis of the problems with the first repairs by Layne Western. He then described each of the proposals and the options. Rusty stated Option #1 would cost \$84,060 and Option #2 would cost \$50,462. Rusty's recommendation was to choose Option #1 for these repairs. After no further comments, the Acting Mayor called for the vote. Voting Yea: Commissioners Brechon, Considine, Kuhn and Acting Mayor Blackburn. Voting Nay: None. Motion carried.

PLACE ON FILE – WELL #5 REPAIR PROJECT PROPOSAL #2 CITY/LAYNE WESTERN

Commissioner Brechon moved that the Well #5 Repair Project Proposal #2 between the City of Dixon and Layne Western be placed on file until the Special Council Meeting of Tuesday, October 14, 2014. Voting Yea: Commissioners Brechon, Considine, Kuhn and Acting Mayor Blackburn. Voting Nay: None. Motion carried.

PLACE ON FILE -ENGINEERING AGREEMENT - BLOODY GULCH BRIDGE REMOVAL & DUTCH ROAD CULVERT WORK PROJECTS CITY/WILLETT, HOFMANN & ASSOCIATES

Commissioner Kuhn moved that the Engineering Agreement between the City of Dixon and Willett, Hofmann & Associates for the Bloody Gulch Bridge Removal and Dutch Road Culvert Work Projects be placed on file until the Special Council Meeting of Tuesday, October 14, 2014. Discussion followed. Commissioner Kuhn advised there is weakening on the bridge due to rust on the metal. He advised it is the recommendation of the engineers to remove the bridge and make it a roadway. Commissioner Kuhn then advised the culvert on Dutch Road has caved in. Rusty Cox advised the culvert is 70 feet from the bridge and a watermain is over the culvert and in poor condition due to washouts. Commissioner Kuhn stated these two projects would be done at the same time, starting in December, 2014. Rusty Cox stated his crews would be used to haul the rock for these projects, saving on costs. After no further comments, the Acting Mayor called for the vote. Voting Yea: Commissioners Brechon, Considine, Kuhn and Acting Mayor Blackburn. Voting Nay: None. Motion carried.
