This set contains the slightly revised first volume dated 1937; when a second volume was projected, the original 1936 volume was reissued in 1937 with some alterations and called "Volume One." In 1894, the editors of McClure Magazine decided to ask readers to submit reminiscences and information relating to Abraham Lincoln, with the intention of establishing something like a library of resources. When an avalanche of responses came, they realized that the material was valuable, but fragmentary and not useful in its raw state. They asked Ida Tarbell (1857-1944), considered the first investigative journalist, to use it to write about Lincoln's early life. Her articles appeared in McClure's in 1895 and 1896. A later series of articles, concludes in 1899, covered Lincoln's later life. The two series of articles, with a good deal of supplementary material, is published in these four volumes published in 1900. Vol. I, x (Preface), 206 p.; Vol. II, 206 p.; Vol. III, 204 p.; Vol. IV, 272 p. The last volume includes an Appendix, pp. 59-255, with Lincoln letters, telegrams, and speeches not found in any of the earlier collections of his writings, and an index to the four volumes. Frontispieces in the volumes are I, portrait of Lincoln; II, full-length portrait of Mary Todd Lincoln; III, bust of Lincoln; IV, a portrait of Lincoln in his later years. All are protected by tissues. Quartos (9 1/2" x 6 1/2" ), hard cover, deep maroon cloth with a replica of Lincoln's signature in gold and an embossed image of him on the front cover, gold titles on the spine, top edges gilt. The title pages are elaborate, printed in black and red. Volumes 1 and 2 have been rebound in buckram and the whole set is former library with the usual markings. Vol. 3 and 4 are in the original bindings. 199.99 6 lb.

Steel engraved frontispiece portrait of Lincoln by A.H. Ritchie, and fifteen other full-page plates throughout. Water-staining in the front section, but otherwise a very good copy of the First Edition. Henry Jarvis Raymond (1820-1869) was a prominent Republican politician and a leading journalist who was co-founder
