Former library book in good condition. Buckram rebind. Missing a small piece (1/2" x 1/8") at the top right on jacket front. Would make a wonderful gift! The film won an Academy Award for Best Song for "On the Atchison, Topeka, and the Santa Fe", written by Harry Warren and Johnny Mercer and sung by Judy Garland. The author was a sergeant of the 9th Illinois Cavalry, the 95th Illinois Infantry, a cavalryman, infantryman and prisoner of war. This personable first hand account of the American Civil War was written as an eyewitness narrative. Tyler was very successful at dispatch riding but was discharged after being wounded. He then enlisted in the infantry where he was captured and interned in the notorious Andersonville Prison of which he concludes his narrative by telling of the appalling conditions and brutality suffered by the Union prisoners. Printed red paper wrappers dirty and chipped with some loss, front cover loose, original staple binding, title on cover, library stamp top of the title page. Otherwise good condition. 149.99

Doubleday, Page & Company, New York, 1908. Illustrated with color frontispiece and numerous black and white photographs. This famous account of Dr. Cook's 1906 expedition to Alaska's Mt. McKinley (now Denali) and his discredited claim to have made the first ascent of the highest mountain in North America is enhanced with the addition of five tipped-in photographs taken by Bradford Washburn, a pioneering mountaineer, outstanding mountain photographer, and longtime director of Boston's Museum of Science. It was these and other matching photographs that helped disprove Cook's claim. From the personal library of noted Arctic expert Lincoln Washburn (no relation to Bradford, but a friend and former expedition companion). His ownership signature appears twice along with an unrelated gift subscription on the front paste-down. Former library book in good condition with a rebound cover in red buckram.
