

No library card and you're out of books to read? We have a solution for that!

This will allow access to our ebook and e-audiobook resources. While we're closed, we are now offering temporary cards that will expire 5/31. This is for both residents and non-residents. To extend the card past 5/31, you will need to come in to the library (once we reopen, of course) and show proof of address and sign a paper registration card agreement. Once we are able to reopen, non-residents will need to pay the rural fee for the year, which is currently \$75 and covers the entire household.
