

DIXON RIVERFRONT COMMISSION  
MINUTES  
August 9, 2011

Chairman Larry Reed called the meeting of the Riverfront Commission to order at 5:32 P.M. In the Council Chambers of the City Hall.

Treasurer Jean Millar reported Riverfront Commission account balance \$50,680.24 and the Maintenance Account balance \$24,325.79. Jean announced that we are enrolled in the Community Matters Program of Fifth Third Bank. This offers Riverfront available for perks and donations available through this program. See attached report. The report was approved and will be referred for auditing.

EXECUTIVE MANAGER'S REPORT

Kay reported on activities during the month of July. The tent used by Petunia Festival will be used again next year and the time appropriated for Community offerings will be worked on as they felt the idea was good, but needed additional planning.

Larry reported on the status of the tent damage in regards to insurance. We have refused to accept a patched tent. We will be able to provide a reasonable tent for use during the September wedding scheduled on the Riverfront.

There are continued problems with the lights in the pools. At the present, to prevent anything serious occurring, the electricity is turned off.

Riverfront is sponsoring a reception at the Crystal Cork following the Reagan Trails Concert Sunday evening. We are encouraged to attend.

Larry reported on the meeting with Dixon Tourism, held August 2 at City Hall. Larry Reed, Colleen Brechon, Edyie Madden and Priscilla Brickley were present.
