### FAMILY STORYTIMES

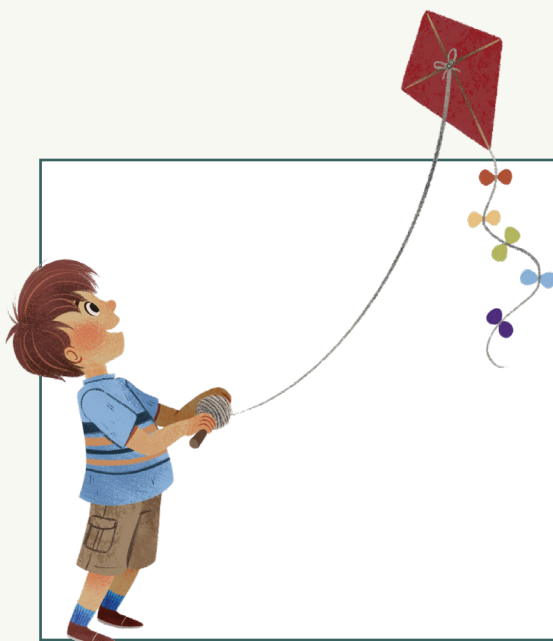
Bring the whole family to the library on Thursday mornings at either **9:30 or 10:30 am** for a fun storytime. These storytimes are geared toward preschoolers but
