

BENEFITS OF READING LARGE PRINT

RETENTION

76% of below grade-level readers had better retention while reading large print materials.



DECODING

With fewer words per page, large print books make the process of visualizing information easier for struggling readers.



RECOGNITION

Word recognition increases as the reader can sound out words for effectively. 57% of special needs students had better letter and word recognition.



COMPREHENSION

Once decoding errors are eliminated and fluency improves, struggling readers can focus on the meaning of the text and vocabulary.



CONFIDENCE

74% of below grade-level readers felt greater confidence in their reading abilities.



FLUENCY

Larger fonts and increased spacing force the eye to move more slowly to help a reader avoid skipping or re-reading lines.



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
