PETITION FOR VARIANCE 409 MADISON AVENUE PETITIONER: DUANE LONG

Chairman Mezo stated the petitioner is asking for a variance to build a 20 feet by 20 feet addition that will extend in the front of the property 17 feet away from the property line. He explained the building must be 25 feet away from the property line and the petitioner is asking for an 8-foot variance.

Burnell asked if any neighbors had any objections due to the location of the addition and commented on his visual concerns. Duane Long said he has had no complaints. Long explained this addition is his second option, his first will be to build a 2nd story addition. He stated it will depend on the loan the bank will offer him.

Motion was made by Kuhn and seconded by Smith to approve an 8 foot setback variance on the southeast corner of 409 Madison Avenue for the purpose of building an addition to the existing house.
